Glocester uses trail paint on trees and home made signs to further reduce cost. Maps are reproduced on the town hall copier and distributed via mailbox at the trailhead (about 1000 per year).

Websites such as ExploreRI.org and Meetup.com were identified as reliable sources of trail information. Good map practices include liability disclosures according to the R.I. Recreational use statute, trail head coordinates and a few "you are here" signs along the route.
