E. Comments from the Chair

Ron Cervasio felt that the Planning Board should act as the research and development arm of the Town Council. It is the Planning Board that should keep bringing new ideas to the Town Council.

F. Blighted Buildings

Ron Cervasio stated that he has pictures of the blighted commercial properties and will provide them to the Planning Board so that the Planning Board can continue to work on remediation.

G. Licensing fees

Ron Cervasio stated that he will make sure that all information gets to the town planner.

H. Proposed Draft Solar Ordinance

Anthony Renzi asked about the 200' setback from the property line and stated that he felt that if it were trees it would obstruct the solar vista.

There was discussion about the number of feet of vegetated buffer, view masking, terrain, etc., and the set-back width.

The suggestion was made that there be a section added specifically on terrain masking. Further discussion included the possible location of solar farms (must be near an electrical three-phase supply), clear-cutting of trees (and possible waiting period after clear cutting if the stated purpose is agricultural before introducing solar).

Decommissioning of solar farms: Burrillville has required replanting of trees in every hole from every installation.

Planner Jennifer Siciliano and Solicitor Joanna Achille will continue to work on the ordinance. Helen Hardy will work with Ms. Siciliano.
