

TOWN OF FOSTER

The Foster Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on July 13, 2023 at 6:00 PM in the Benjamin Eddy Building, 6 South Killingly Road, Foster, RI 02825. FEMA is providing updated FIRMs (Flood Insurance Rate Maps) and an updated FIS (Flood Insurance Study) for Providence County, RI on July 19, 2023.

The Town of Foster has elected to comply with the requirements of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (P.L. 90-488, as amended). To remain compliant with the minimum criteria of the National Flood Insurance Program Floodplain Management Regulations, the Town of Foster is required to amend or add the following ordinances: Foster Code of Ordinances Sec. 26-132, Sec. 26-133, Sec. 26-134, and Sec. 26-138.

The proposed amendments can be reviewed at Town Hall at 181 Howard Hill Road in the Planning Department during normal business hours by appointment only.
