Correspondence:

- The FLT received a letter of appreciation from Anne Cardoza for the level of maintenance on the trails.
- FLT received from the Nature Conservancy (TNC) a copy of the conservation easement for the Hayfield property. The Colwell property easement has not been received but is expected to be comparable to the Hayfield easement.
- The FLT plans to tour both properties with the TNC in January.
- A complaint regarding a sinkhole on the Rams Tail Trail was received. The sinkhole is not on FLT property so no action will be taken.
- Mr. May put forward a motion to explore the possibility of a solar farm on the Delvechio property. Mr. Therrien 2nd and motion passed on a 4 to 1 vote.
