Whereas, said plan now known as RhodeMapRI has not received adequate public scrutiny from the Council and the citizens of the Town of Foster and the citizens of The State of Rhode Island;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved: That the Town of Foster and its duly elected representatives respectfully request the Division of Planning and Rhode Island General Assembly utilize all its powers and authority to postpone the adoption of **RhodeMapRI** until the 2015 legislative session, during which time the duly elected representatives of the people together with the public may closely scrutinize the merits of this plan;

Be It Further Resolved, that upon passage the Town Clerk shall forward this resolution to every State Senator and State Representative, the Governor, Governor-elect and every Rhode Island Municipality.
