

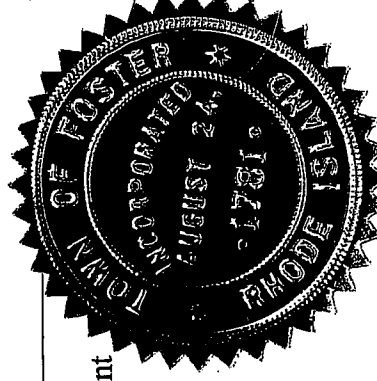


WHEREAS, **Christopher J. Morissette** has completed Snorkeling BSA and has also been awarded the Bishop Tobin Award and

WHEREAS, **Christopher J. Morissette**, for his Eagle Service Project, cleared brush from an overgrown historical cemetery in Foster and


