## Town of Foster Refuse and Recycling Guide

## Items that the Central Landfill WILL NOT accept and that Rambone Disposal WILL NOT pick up

- Any waste generated outside of Rhode Island
- Ceramics & pottery, including dishes, vases & knickknacks (dishes may be dropped off at a pod behind the Foster Public Works garage)
- Windshield glass or laminated glass, including Pyrex cooking pans
- > Industrial hazardous waste
- ➤ Household hazardous waste (contact Eco-depot at 942-1430, ext. 241)
- > Regulated medical waste
- > Asbestos
- > Liquid waste, such as septic, sludge, contaminated run-off or vehicle fluids
- Radioactive waste
- Odorous waste (such as large quantities of spoiled fish, acceptance to be determined by landfill personnel)
- Non-hazardous industrial waste (treated or untreated)
- > Oil-spill clean up materials or oil contaminated materials (including Speedi-Dri and oil-spill absorbents)
- Pathological waste (treated or untreated)
- Untreated infectious waste (no medical wasted is accepted except for that which is home-generated such as hypodermic needles, tissues and bandaids)
- Hypodermic needles / sharps from medical facilities (this does not include sewing needles which may be discarded in the trash)
- > Tree liquids
- ➤ Hot loads (this would be anything still burning or only partially extinguished)
- > Dead animals
- Aerosol containers that have not been fully discharged
- Untreated storage tanks
- Untreated industrial containers
- > Septic materials
- Uncured materials such as partially composted waste
- Sludge and liquid wastes unapproved by RIRRC\*
- Industrial waste not approved by RIRRC\*
- Projects in excess of 1,000 yards or 1,000 tons without prior approval of RIRRC\*
